THE PACK WAS DESIGNED BY NIALL MONRO (BETWEEN NOVEMBER 89 AND APRIL 1990). AT THAT TIME MONRO WORKED FOR THE RAYMOND LOEWY GROUP WHO WERE RETAINED BY PHILIP MORRIS. SHOWN ON THE PACKAGE IS A PIECE OF GRAFFITI-COVERED SLAB BEING REMOVED FROM THE WALL. ITS BUBBLY LETTERS READ STAR.
