A monographic book celebrating fifteen staircase murals by Lothar Götz, published for the opening of 'Xanadu' which was commissioned for the reopening of Leeds Art Gallery in November 2017 and supported by the Art Fund, Art Happens. The book is perfect bound, with 120 pages in luscious colour and pays tribute in form and size to *Reclam books (Reclam Verlag or just Reclam is a German publishing house, established in Leipzig in 1828 by Anton Philipp Reclam (1807–1896). It is particularly well-known for the 'little yellow books' of its Universal-Bibliothek (Universal Library), simple paperback editions of literary classics for school and education). Correction

A lithograph is built up through a myriad of juxtaposing colours to engage with ideas of space and abstraction. This signed volume brings together over 30 drawings by the artist alongside an essay by Charles Darwent. Brought together in dense compositions on painted card and board, Götz's drawings explore the impact of using varying colours and intensities on the work's surface. The edition includes the four-colour lithograph Correction (2015), which layers silver, green, pink and black on white Somerset Satin. Each edition is hand-finished by the artist and contained within a custom-made slipcase. The lithograph was completed in close collaboration between Götz and Hole Editions.

Line Drawings

Engaging with ideas of space and abstraction, Lothar Götz's line drawings are built up through layers of juxtaposing colours. Perhaps best known for his large-scale wall paintings and installations, Götz's drawings lie at the centre of his practice. Brought together in dense compositions on painted card and board, Götz's thin pencil lines explore the impact of using varying colours and intensities on the work's surface. Referencing and expanding upon the abstract language of Suprematism and the Bauhaus, the colours appear to oscillate in front of the viewer to immerse them in the surrounding space.
